可以穿的建筑 Built to Wear

Ball Nogues / 美国 USA

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美国艺术家Benjamin Ball和Gaston Nogues多年前即开始合作。他们精巧优雅的装置作品曾在纽约现代艺术博物馆与2009年威尼斯双年展上展出，并被大量收藏。这些作品见证了他们在材料和建筑理念上的革新。在此次参加深港双年展的项目中，二人进行了新的尝试。一万两千件从美国洛杉矶Apparel公司的仓库直接运来的短袖运动衫、裤子、胸罩、围巾、比基尼、裙子、毛衣、狗服装和婴儿服等，通过衣服夹子固定在线上，形成吊挂的可伸张的网状结构。“可以穿的建筑”是一件在展览过程中会改变的装置。衣服不会一直挂在线上。网状结构所受承受的重力会不断减轻，到1月23号，一切都将消失。（碧翠斯·盖里）

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American artists Benjamin Ball and Gaston Nogues have been working together since years ago. Their innovation with material and structure has seen a number of exquisitely elegant installations at the Museum of Modern Art in New York, the Venice Biennale and a number of private clients in their native Los Angeles. In Shenzhen, they experiment with a tensile net structure from which 12,000 T-shirts, pants, bras, scarves, bikinis, shirts, sweaters, dog clothes, and baby bibs shipped directly from the American Apparel warehouse in Los Angeles hanging with only a clothes clip to keep them on the line. "Built to Wear" will change during the course of the exhibition: the clothes will not stay on the line, the weight on the net structure will decrease and by 23 January, there will be nothing left of it at all.
